In 1999, the Fusion Festival Germany (U-Site Crew) was still a little insider tip and very manageable with 3 stages. The concert by B. Ashra and Ricky Deadking was scheduled as the opening set for the trance stage on Saturday late afternoon until sunset. It starts very chilled and slowly becomes more beat-heavy. The track "Rising High" was also very suitable for sunset and announced it full-in-time (see cover), before the following 3 tracks ushered in the planned dance floor with minimal techno.

The double album "Live at U-Site Fusion" by B. Ashra & Ricky Deadking of the complete, uncut, legendary concert was produced for the first time in 2000 as a limited edition of 100 copies as a CDR. Shortly after its release, the label BTM (Bochumer Ton Manufaktur) was interested in the recording and released an edited version of the concert reduced to one CD.

After a short time it was sold out and has not been available for over 20 years. The CDR version was no longer offered after the official release, a few original CDRs (with the correct print) from back then have now resurfaced. ;) So far, only CD owners were able to hear the album, but now it is also available as a remastered digital/online release.

In memory of Alexander Rues (aka Ricky Deadking aka Eru), he left us in May 2019 † R.I.P. Lex! !!! It was all the more important to us to make this contemporary testimony available digitally.
